- 10-Road Update-Mayor Huggins reported that we have some road damage, the weeds are coming up on the west edge of the road. I have notified the company they will try and come out next week.
- 11-.Planning Commission report-Councilmember Bell reported Brian from BRAG was at the meeting and we are going to take sections and work on the master plan he said it should take 6 to 8 months to complete.
- 8-Park Update-Councilmember Huggins reported she walked through the cleaning job with Kylee.

9- Roof repairs or replacement-Councilmember Huggins reported she got the roof bids, Homer was the lowest for \$15,280.00 the roof has a 50 year warranty. We will still have to do more work due to the water leaking. I would suggest we go with the bid from Homer.
